

## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT**

### **FOR WEBSTER UNIVERSITY TRAVEL ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Webster University Travel Accident Insurance, EIN 43-0662529, Plan No. 501, which provides Travel Accident Insurance benefits, for period June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### **Insurance Information**

The plan has a contract with AIG Life Insurance Co. to pay claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending May 31, 2006 were \$1,500.

#### **Your Rights To Additional Information**

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in that report:

1. insurance information, including sales commissions paid by insurance carriers.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan (Webster University, 470 E. Lockwood Ave., St. Louis, MO 63119-3141) and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
