- Completed and signed application form
- A nonrefundable \$50 application fee (waived for Webster M.A.T. graduates)
- A curriculum vitae (or résumé)
- Official transcripts from all colleges and universities
- Three (3) letters of recommendation
- Admission interview
- Essay

It is the applicant's responsibility to make sure that the application file is complete. If an application file is not complete before the eighth week of the term, the applicant will be dropped from future courses and the application withdrawn.

After all of your required admission materials have been received, your application will be reviewed and you will be notified of the Committee's decision.
