Here's what you can expect:

Advising Presentation

Our program opens with a half hour presentation by the Advising staff. We will explain the nuts and bolts of your academic program and present a number of very useful tools like the Undergraduate Catalog and Course Schedule as well as the University's electronic network that you will use again and again during your time at Webster.

Advising Workshop

Over the next half hour, faculty and staff advisors will stop by to help you put together your schedule. You will choose a Freshman Seminar, some introductory courses for your major, and some general education courses. In the course of this time, you will meet several of your future professors.

Registration/Student Affairs Inventory

After the workshop, half of you will go with a faculty or staff advisor to register for your classes. We will be using the same system you will use when you register yourself in subsequent semesters. The other half of you will answer an important inventory for Student Affairs.

While you are registering, your parents will hear a presentation from the Student Affairs staff on what parents should know about college life today.
