Globalized Legal Studies Program - Summer 2010 - Leiden, The Netherlands **Deadline for Application: April 15, 2010**

Tuition: Summer tuition rates are estimated and will not be finalized until mid-April 2010

Undergraduate..... estimated - \$575 per credit hour
Graduate.....estimated - \$670 per credit hour

Lab Fee: \$100.00 per course

Tuition and the appropriate lab fee will be charged directly to each student's Webster account

Study Abroad Fee - \$250.00 (one time charge): includes welcome reception each week, international health insurance, International Student Identity Card (ISIC), and Lonely Planet Guide Book to the Netherlands.

Housing Administrative Fee: \$110.00 (one time charge)

Housing: \$440.00 per week (campus housing)
