- Completed application.
- Non-refundable application fee \$125 payable to Webster University. (Fee waived for Webster graduates.)
- Your resume.
- Doctoral Application Statement (should be 4-6 pages, type written and double-spaced.) Address how this program would facilitate your personal and career goals. Describe relevant work and personal experiences in your discussion, and what you could contribute to the class group's learning experience.
- GMAT Exam Score. Contact the General Management Admissions Council to either take the exam, or to forward prior exam scores which are no more than 5 years old.

### YOU WILL ALSO NEED TO:

- Request each of the colleges and universities you have attended to send official transcripts of all previous graduate and undergraduate work. Transcripts should be sent directly to the Director of the Doctor of Management program from the issuing institution. No "issued to student" transcripts will be accepted. Former Webster students must request original Webster transcripts from the Registrar when applying.
- Request from three (3) different individuals a letter of recommendation on your behalf telling us your qualifications to be part of this program. These letters should be from faculty and/or professional associates. Recommendations should be sent the Director of the Doctor of Management program.
