The *Consuelo E. Gallagher Spanish Scholarship* is an annual, nonrenewable scholarship awarded to an incoming freshman or transfer student majoring in Spanish at Webster's St. Louis campus. Freshman applicants must have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.3 or higher and have successfully completed a minimum of two years of Spanish coursework at the high school level. A letter of recommendation from high school Spanish teacher is required and must be attached to this application at the time of submission.

Transfer applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.3 or higher from all college coursework previously attempted and have successfully completed a minimum of 4 semesters of college-level Spanish coursework. A letter of recommendation from Spanish professor is required and must be attached to this application at the time of submission.

Applications received without an accompanying letter of recommendation will not be considered.
