Presidential Scholarship Program Webster University

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION: The Presidential Scholarship is a competitive full tuition award for outstanding undergraduate students who enroll at Webster as first-time freshmen. The scholarship is renewable for a total of eight consecutive semesters. Awardees must maintain full-time (13 hours or more), consecutive enrollment at Webster and maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale). The scholarship does not apply to summer sessions. This is the highest academic award given to any student at Webster. A maximum of five Presidential Scholarships may be awarded per year. Awards for 2010-2011 will be valued at over \$85,000 for four years.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must meet two of the following criteria to apply:

- Cumulative GPA of 3.80 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Minimum 29 ACT composite, or 1900 combined SAT Reasoning Test
- Rank in the top 10% of graduating class from high school

Note: If school does not rank, applicants should meet GPA and test score requirement.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: All application materials must be *received*, and admission files completed by January 13, 2010.

HOW TO APPLY: To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must submit the following materials by January 13, 2010:

1. Completed Application for Admission (including *all* required supporting materials)
2. Completed Presidential Scholarship Application

The University Scholarship Committee will review the applications, and candidates will be notified of their status by January 23, 2009.

Finalists are chosen on the basis of their academic background (curriculum, grade point average, and test scores), essay and involvement in leadership activities. **In addition, finalists must be able to participate in on-campus interviews at Webster University on Saturday, February 13, 2010.** On that day, candidates will be asked to interview with Webster faculty, students and staff members, and participate in a group activity with other finalists. Parents are encouraged to attend since Admission representatives will be on hand, and campus tours will be available. An optional lunch will be provided at the conclusion of the interviews.

Ten finalists will be selected for the on-campus interviews, and up to five scholarships will be awarded.

PLEASE NOTE: Awarding of the Presidential Scholarship *replaces any previously awarded Webster University Scholarship funds.*
