The Phi Theta Kappa Distinguished Achievement Scholarship is a **full tuition award** which will be granted to an outstanding member of Phi Theta Kappa who enrolls at the Webster University St. Louis campus as an undergraduate transfer student. The scholarship is renewable for a total of four consecutive semesters. Recipient must maintain full-time (13 -18 credit hours per semester) consecutive enrollment at Webster and maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 (on a 4.0 scale). Recipient will also be required to participate in Webster's Student Leadership Development Program, including serving as a Webster University Student Ambassador. The scholarship does not apply to summer sessions or on-campus housing. This is the highest academic award given to any transfer student at Webster University.

**Qualifications:** Candidate must

- be an **active member** in good standing of Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society
- Have achieved a **lifetime cumulative grade point average of 3.7** or higher on all college work attempted (as calculated by Webster University)
- complete an **Associate degree** prior to enrollment at Webster
- be a **U.S. citizen or permanent resident**
- **enroll directly** at Webster University **St. Louis campus** as a **flat-fee full-time student**
- **within one semester** of community college graduation
- be seeking the **first Bachelor's degree**

**Application Deadline:** All application materials must be received and admission files completed by **April 1**. Early application is encouraged.

**How to Apply:** To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must submit the following materials by **April 1**:

1. **Application for admission** ([http://www.webster.edu/admissions/pdf/ug\\_app.pdf](http://www.webster.edu/admissions/pdf/ug_app.pdf)) including **\$35 nonrefundable fee, essay and resume**
2. **Official transcript(s)** mailed directly from each post-secondary institution attended
3. Phi Theta Kappa Distinguished Achievement **Scholarship Application form**
4. **Proof of membership** in Phi Theta Kappa (copy of card or certificate)
5. **Recommendation** from Phi Theta Kappa Chapter or Regional Advisor

Recipient will be chosen by the University Scholarship Committee on the basis of academic accomplishment, essay, recommendation and demonstrated leadership ability. All candidates will be notified of their status by April 30, 2006. The Phi Theta Kappa Distinguished Achievement Scholarship replaces any previous academic scholarship award offered to the student by Webster University.
