**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

**Applicants will:**

- Be an undergraduate student at any Webster University campus in the U.S. planning an international study experience at any Webster University campus abroad, and must be planning to study one to five terms.
- Be a degree-seeking Webster undergraduate student during the semester/terms of application. Applicants must have demonstrated academic ability with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3 in all coursework completed at Webster. **All applicants must have attained sophomore, junior, or senior status with 30 credit hours in residence at Webster.**
- Pay tuition for and maintain full-time enrollment status (6 or more hours during each 8-week term or 12 hours if you are studying abroad for a 16-week semester).
- Submit the following documents to complete the scholarship application process by the application deadline:
  1. A completed scholarship application.
  2. ***Statement of Educational Purpose*** which includes an outline of the planned study experience, including courses to be taken and their relationship to your educational and career goals.
  3. Short autobiographical sketch that can be used for publicity.

**FINANCIAL AID:** Students who receive restricted fund scholarships may be eligible for other forms of financial aid. When the Office of Financial Aid determines a student's eligibility for financial aid funds, restricted scholarships are treated as a student resource and are considered in the calculation of unmet need.
