

## WEBSTER UNIVERSITY GRADUATE STUDENT GRANTS

Did you know that if you enroll in any of Webster University's graduate degree programs you may be selected to receive a \$1,000 grant for the Spring 2006 semester? Some time ago Webster began operation as a lender under the Federal Family Educational Loan Program which has enabled us to provide benefits to graduate students that were previously unavailable. You will receive a rebate equal to 1% of your loan amount\* and you may also be selected to receive an additional \$1,000 grant! To be considered for this award simply complete the checklist below, sign it, and turn it in to your Campus Director.

- Make sure that you are enrolled for at least 3 credit hours in both the Spring I 2006 and Spring II 2006 terms.
- Make sure that you file a 2005/06 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible. The quickest way to do this is on-line via the internet at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) For purposes of selecting grant recipients, priority will be given to those that file their FAFSA by 3/1/06.
- Make sure that you review the information on the back of this form and that if you have any questions regarding the graduate student grant program you discuss them either with you local campus officials or your Financial Aid Counselor.
- Make sure that you complete the information below and turn the bottom portion of this form to your local Campus Director.

\* To receive the 1% rebate you must select Webster University as your lender and remain enrolled continuously through the time that your loan is fully disbursed. Grant recipients must demonstrate financial need as documented by the results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q :** What happens after I turn in my application?

**A :** Your campus officials will collect all of the applications they receive and forward them to the main Financial Aid Office in St. Louis which will verify that you meet the federal need criteria. Final selection of recipients that demonstrate financial need will be determined by your campus administration.

**Q:** How will the grants be distributed if I am selected to receive one?

**A:** Grants will be credited to your account with the university. If there are no charges on your account at that time, the Business Office will issue a refund check to you. In the event that there are outstanding charges on your account, this credit will reduce them by the amount of the grant.

**Q:** Will I receive this grant every year?

**A:** Although you may apply for, and ultimately receive, this grant in subsequent years, it is not renewable.

**Q:** Will all students that meet the need criteria and enrollment requirements qualify for consideration to receive this grant?

**A:** Webster University employees or their dependents receiving tuition remission benefits from the university are not eligible for grant consideration.
