

## FAQs

- *Where do you recruit?*

The GIE has long-standing relationships in Austria, China, Germany, Japan, Mexico, The Netherlands, Switzerland and the UK. Beginning in 2012, we will also recruit international students currently studying in St. Louis at Webster University.

- *What does the corporate fee cover?*

The corporate fee of \$6000/placement covers intern recruitment, selection, visa processing, orientation, infrastructure support and a stipend equivalent to minimum wage for an 8-week internship.

- *What skills do your Global Interns bring to the workplace?*

Global Interns are selected based on exceptional academic accomplishments in their major field of study as well as proficiency in the English language. Each intern has demonstrated an intense drive to excel in a U.S. placement.

- *Does our company need to provide benefits?*

No, Global Interns arrive with health insurance coverage and do not require any benefits from the host organization.

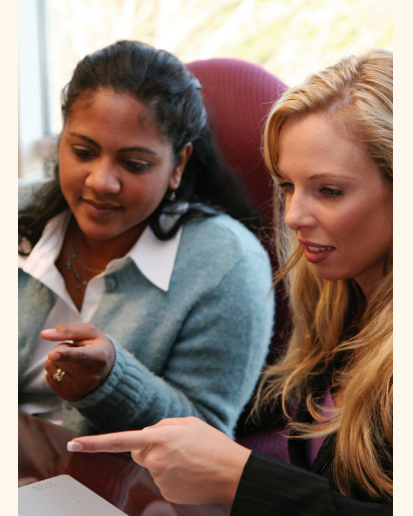
