

## **FAQ's for Choosing a Practicum and Internship Site**

### **How to register for COUNS 6000 and 6500**

- **What do I need to do six months before I plan to register for COUN 6000 or 6500?**

You must attend an orientation session that is held the first Wednesday of each term at 5:45pm.

You must meet with an academic advisor to make certain that you have completed the appropriate course work.

- **In order to complete the registration process for COUN 6000 and COUN 6500, you must have the following:**

Make an appointment to meet with an academic advisor to approve your COUN 6000/6500 packet.

Once you receive approval, you must attach the packet to your registration form. This can be accomplished by making one appointment with an academic advisor.

The approval for your packet and registration can occur at the same time.

- **What do I consider in choosing a practicum or internship site?**

In choosing your site, you need to consider that the site aligns with your professional and academic goals and Webster University's academic mission.

Make certain the site will provide meaningful experience for professional growth.

A licensed professional has to provide supervision.

- **Can I do my internship at the same site that I did my practicum of first Internship?**

Possibly. There is one exception. If you are with a large agency or non-profit organization, you may do your internship with a different population, different set of goals and different professional goals.
