SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships for qualified **new undergraduate applicants** whose citizenship/residency is other than USA range from \$2,000 to \$8,000 per academic year. To apply, please submit a brief statement entitled "Why I Would like a Webster University Scholarship." Scholarships for the academic year beginning in August are awarded only in March. Therefore, it is important to apply no later than February. Note: Citizens and Permanent Residents of the United States are eligible for alternative Webster University scholarships and US federal financial aid programs.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) / ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

Students who complete the full IB Diploma will receive Advanced Standing credit. Our IB credit policy for Diploma holders is as follows: eight semester cr. hrs. for Higher Level (HL) scores of 6 or 7; six semester cr. hrs. for HL scores of 4 or 5; three semester cr. hrs. for Secondary Level scores of 4 or above; no credit for any score of 3 or below. 32 cr. hr. maximum award. Advanced Placement exam scores of three or above receive between 3 and 6 credit hours per exam.
