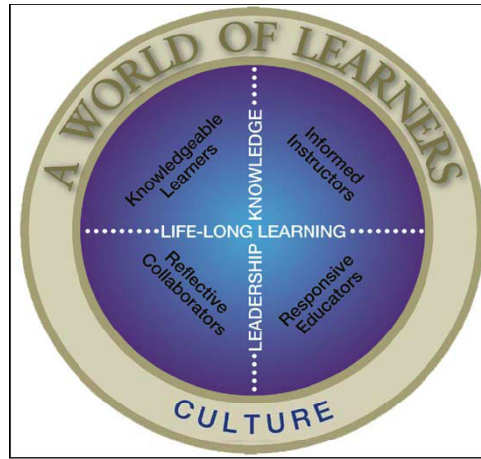

PROGRAM PURPOSES

Since 1966, more than 3000 Kansas City-area teachers have earned the M.A.T. degree at Webster University-Kansas City. Now we are pleased to offer a **Missouri ESOL Teaching Certification** program through the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE).

Our new Missouri ESOL Certification program is designed for preK-12 teachers working with non-English speakers in regular, bilingual, or English Language Learner (ELL) U.S. classrooms.

Those who complete the ESOL certification program will be well prepared to teach students in their classroom the English language and academic skills critical for future success in the United States.



MISSOURI STATE ESOL CERTIFICATION

ESOL certification through the state of Missouri requires completion of 21 credit hours. The University also approves this program for certification in other states.

According to DESE, Spanish, Bosnian/Serb/Croatian, Vietnamese, Arabic, and Somali are the five most common foreign languages spoken by Missouri students.
