Graduate Application: Complete an online application and submit fee to Webster University.

Admissions: Prospective students must successfully complete an admission process before entering the MA Counseling program. All required documents and information are to be addressed and mailed to:

Letters of Recommendation: Three letters of recommendation, including one from a former professor/instructor on his or her letterhead.

Admissions Essay Question:

Provide your name, current date, term/year for which you are applying to the Counseling Program and current contact information (to include email and phone) at the top of the page.

Respond to the following statement in a 1-2 page type-written, double-spaced format.

Comment on your personal and professional interests in the field of professional counseling. Include personal background and work history related to your interest in the field of professional counseling and career goals in the field of professional counseling; also include your thoughts regarding your potential success in forming effective and culturally relevant interpersonal relationships in individual and small group contexts and your aptitude for succeeding in graduate level education.

All letters of recommendation and the admissions essay will be submitted together, under one cover, to the address listed above.

Official Transcript: An official, unopened transcript must be received **before** any admission documents will be processed. The official, unopened transcript may be included in the envelope containing the recommendations and the essay.

Group Interview: A group interview will be scheduled by the Counseling Admissions Committee. The applicant will be informed of the date and time.
