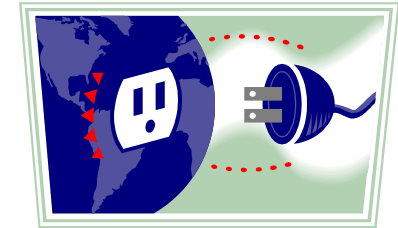

Emerson Library offers a wealth of resources and special services to students, faculty & staff to support your academic research and teaching. **Passports**, the website for the Eden Webster Library System, is the online gateway to these resources and services.

LIBRARY CATALOG: The catalog lists over 300,000 items including 1,600 periodical titles and almost 9000 video/DVDs, owned by the library. Click on [New Titles](#) under "What's New" on the [Passports main page](#) to view a monthly list of items added to the library. Use our Document Delivery service to have books delivered directly to your home or office.

ELECTRONIC BOOKS: The library offers over 15,000 current and classic **e-books** covering a variety of subjects. Records for our e-books appear in the library catalog with a hot link to the electronic book. E-books can also be searched in the *netLibrary* database, available from the menu of Passports databases. netLibrary allows searching of a topic across a database of electronic books.

ELECTRONIC JOURNALS: Passports databases offer electronic full text from over 24,000 academic journals, newspapers, magazines through Online/Fulltext Databases.

VIDEO COLLECTION: The library offers educational videos and DVDs on many topics. Use the library catalog or the [Video/DVDs link](#) to search the videos by title, keyword, genre or language. Faculty are advised to reserve videos early for use in the classroom. Online form:

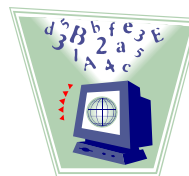
ONLINE/FULLTEXT DATABASES [http://library.webster.edu/databases/ database.html](http://library.webster.edu/databases/database.html)

Over 120 research databases provide access to scholarly resources appropriate to your research needs. Our subscription databases offer thousands of fulltext journal, magazine, & newspaper articles, reference, business & legal information, and bibliographic citations from published sources in many subject areas.

Passports databases cover all subjects: the humanities, social sciences, business & computers, nursing & science, and also include general/multidisciplinary databases.

USE YOUR WEBSTER ID NUMBER FOR DATABASE ACCESS: Your unique, 7-digit ID number is the password for all Passports databases. If you don't know your number, or if it does not work, **contact the staff at your campus**, or Rick Kaeser at docdel@webster.edu.

PASSPORTS TUTORIALS: Online tutorials and research guides are available on the Passports main menu. Click [Research Guides](#) under the [Help](#) link on the main page.

LOCATING FULL TEXT ARTICLES: If the database you are searching does not link to the full-text, check the [Journal Magazine Newspaper List](#) linked from the Articles/Databases page. Search the journal name to determine if it is available fulltext in another Passports database or in print in the library's collection. If it is online, you can link to the database and search for the article you need. If the journal is in the library collection, request a copy through the Document Delivery Service.

DOCUMENT DELIVERY: Webster students worldwide may request library materials. For articles, check the [Journal Magazine Newspaper List](#) to see if we subscribe to the periodical. For books, check the library catalog to make certain Emerson owns the book. Document Delivery is linked under request books or articles. We post articles from our periodicals in 2 business days. If you wish us to request articles from another library, allow 7 days. Books are delivered via UPS; allow at least 7 business days.

ELECTRONIC RESERVES: E-Reserves allow faculty to post electronic documents and web links on a secure server for their classes. To access E-Reserves, or set up & administer an account, see <http://ereserves.webster.edu/eres>

TURNITIN PLAGIARISM DATABASE: Turnitin checks assignments & papers for originality against Internet pages as well as a growing database of previously submitted student work. Faculty must apply for an account and may either submit electronic copies of student papers or allow students to submit their own.
