**Gabriel Bolkosky** is a classical and jazz violinist and Suzuki teacher. Born and raised in Detroit, Michigan, he started violin lessons at the age of three. His primary mentors were Michael Avsharian of Ann Arbor, Paul Kantor at the University of Michigan, and Donald Weilerstein at the Cleveland Institute of Music. Mr. Bolkosky earned a bachelor's degree in music and a master's degree in chamber music, as well as studying improvisation at the master's level, at the University of Michigan. At the Cleveland Institute he earned a Professional Studies degree, served a year as Weilerstein's teaching assistant and won the Darius Milhaud prize. He is a sought-after teacher and guest artist at Suzuki Institutes and workshops across America. Mr. Bolkosky is the executive director of The Phoenix Ensemble, a non-profit arts organization that is dedicated to helping artists. He has 6 CDs out, including the solo CD, *This and That*, a combination of classical and jazz music, and *Home From Work*, a blend of jazz, folk, and blues. Mr. Bolkosky is known for his ability to draw audiences into his performances, and move them with his playing, as well as his passion, great sense of humor, and his exceptional teaching abilities. He maintains a private studio in Ann Arbor, Michigan.
