KINDERMUSIK FOR THE YOUNG CHILD

In this sequential program, children will explore many facets of music – speaking and singing, moving, listening, creating, and playing instruments, and learning about reading and writing music. During each class, creative movement or dances are interspersed with quiet activities like drawing or focused listening. The curriculum introduces the glockenspiel – a pre-keyboard instrument (semesters 1, 2, 3, 4), and string and wind instruments – the dulcimer (semester 3) and recorder (semester 4). *For the Young Child* broadens and deepens the child's introduction to the fulfillment and excitement of musicianship.

This is the perfect pressure-free preparation for private OR group instrumental instruction.

Spring Semester 4

In this final semester, we'll introduce the recorder instrument. As your child is introduced to basic methods of playing simple melodic patterns and songs on this wind instrument, we'll also incorporate the instruments, concepts, and songs from previous semesters. With a special emphasis on multicultural music, your child will learn to improvise and write music, as well as experience the musical styles of the Pacific Islands, Europe, and Africa; plus play special dances and children's games from around the world, including Alpine dances, Mexico, and Ecuador.

Join the adventures of Beethoven Bear and Mozart Mouse as they travel from play room to the practice room to the recital hall. *Music for Little Mozarts* combines age-appropriate piano instruction with general musicianship activities to promote overall musical development. Skills taught include listening, pitch matching, keyboard technique and performance, singing, rhythm, movement, and music appreciation.

Parents, as in all music lessons for young children, play a very important role in *Music for Little Mozarts*. Parents are required to attend lessons and share in the learning process at home as they partner with their child to lay the foundation for a lifetime of musical enjoyment. Parents must supervise practice and read directions to the student. In addition to practice sessions at the piano, parents should discuss the pictures in the books with the child, read the story in the Music Lesson Book to him/her, and listen to the CDs together as a family.

Fifteen minutes of practice time three to five days per week is requested. You will be required to have either a piano or a touch-sensitive electronic keyboard with full-sized keys on which your child and you can practice at home.

*New children may be considered for acceptance into Music for Little Mozarts Semester 2 if they meet one or both of the following criteria:

1. Have had previous piano experience
2. Have a parent/caregiver with piano experience. Parent/caregiver can purchase Music for Little Mozarts Semester 1 Lesson Book and Work Book and help student prepare for Music for Little Mozarts Semester 2 concepts.
