

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
FOR ADVANCED STANDING
BETWEEN
NILAI INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE
AND WEBSTER UNIVERSITY WORLDWIDE**

Nilai International College (“the college”) and Webster University Worldwide (“the university”) agree to establish an arrangement whereby academically successful students who complete an American Degree Program Course at the College are eligible for admission consideration into the Bachelor’s Degree Program at Webster University Worldwide.

Whereas the parties hereby agree as follows:-

1. CONDITION OF ENTRY AND STUDY PROGRAMS

- 1.1 The conditions of entry and the intended study programs for these students are set out in Schedule A. INTERNATIONAL RECRUITMENT
- 1.2 Any student admitted under this agreement will be subject to current University catalog and related admission policies at the time of entrance to the University. The University reserves the right to review and amend such policies at any time during the period of this Memorandum of Understanding. The College will be updated on an annual basis with the print catalog and other supplementary materials as they become available.
- 1.3 The College will update the University of any substantive program changes covered in this agreement on an annual basis and/or at the point of occurrence.

2. SERVICES

- 2.1 Students accepted into the university will pay fees direct to the University in accordance with the published tuition and fees for the campus location, academic program, and enrollment period.
- 2.2 The College will provide accurate information, necessary advice and related service to the student during the application process for transfer to the University.
- 2.3 The College shall provide the University with official transcripts of applicants work to date at the point of application and upon completion of student’s enrollment at the College, as well as any other appropriate evaluations of student performance.

3. PROMOTION

This agreement allows both parties to advertise and promote the articulation arrangement by describing this MOU, and the parties shall provide each other with copies of such advertisements, brochures and promotional materials.


4. GENERAL

- 4.1 This MOU shall commence on the date of signature by authorized academic officers from each institution. Unless otherwise terminated, this MOU shall be automatically renewed at the end of each calendar year.
- 4.2 Any terms or provision of this MOU may be varied by mutual consent in writing by both parties.
- 4.3 Either institution may, by written notice of six (6) months, give notice to the other of its intention to terminate the agreement.
- 4.4 If this MOU is terminated as set out in Clause 4.3, it is agreed by the parties that any student who at the date of termination, has been enrolled at the University may complete that course of study under the terms of this MOU.


