

Student Success Committee

The Student Success Committee meets monthly to discuss students who are deemed in some way “at risk”. This could be because of academics, behavior in class, financial, illness, family illness or mental state. The committee is lead by the Dean of Students, a representative of Academic Advising, and the Head of the Academic Resource Center. Other areas of the university that are represented are: the business office, counseling, financial aid, health services, housing. The School of Communications Academic Advisor is the only school represented on the committee.

Anyone can refer a student to the Student Success Committee: faculty, staff, or student. The committee also maintains an online At Risk Alert available to faculty. Some of the issues are addressed directly to the student through their Academic Advisor; and are never brought up before the group. Other students are discussed at the monthly meeting. Whenever possible, committee members will follow up on specific issues regarding the student’s problem.

The Student Success Committee’s mission is that a student finds all avenues of help that are available at Webster University.
