The William T. Kemper Foundation will again allow Webster University to recognize two full-time faculty members who will receive a \$10,000 award, and two adjunct faculty members who will receive a \$5,000 award. We are inviting nominations for the 2007 *William T. Kemper Award for Excellence in Teaching*.

This is your opportunity to nominate one Webster University full-time faculty member and one part-time faculty member who, in your opinion, exhibits the art of teaching at its finest. Please include a short paragraph stating why you think this individual is an outstanding teacher. Nominees will then be asked to provide certain pertinent background information on their teaching experiences as well as a statement articulating their philosophy of education. For the part-time faculty award, the committee will give preference to professional practitioners (adjunct faculty) who have taught for three or more years.

The Executive Vice President will appoint a committee consisting of alumni, faculty, and administration to review the nominations and their materials and to select the four finalists. Announcement of the 2007 *William T. Kemper Award for Excellence in Teaching* will be made at the end of the academic year at an appropriate ceremony.

Your nomination of one full-time and/or one part-time faculty member, as well as your short paragraph stating why you think this individual is an outstanding teacher, is due in the office of the Executive Vice President by **Monday, February 12, 2007**. Please address your nominations to:
