

HLC Criteria V: Engagement and Services
Webster University Thailand
(WUT)

5A) The organization learns from the constituencies it serves and analyzes its capacity to serve their needs and expectations.

WUT offers undergraduate and graduate programs under the same curriculum as Webster University St. Louis. Programs offered include Bachelor of Arts in Business, Psychology, Media Communications, and International Relations, Bachelor of Sciences in Computer Science, Master of Arts in International Relations, and Media Communications, and Master of Business Administration. WUT programs are also accredited by Thai government.

WUT has set up the Executive Board (EB) to oversee WUT operations. WUT has several sub-committees and working groups reporting to the EB.

Course evaluation is conducted each term. Students' responses are analyzed by the Rector. Campus Life evaluation is conducted annually.

Our student body consists of around 30 nationalities. WUT maintain an Equal Opportunities Policy. There is a Student Counseling service run by a WUT psychology professor. Student Services Department provides care to all students as well as to organized student activities.

Each program organizes educational fieldtrips, and invites guest speakers on campus.

WUT welcomes study-aboard students mainly from other Webster campuses. Each program provides internships to students either at local or international companies.

5B) The organization has the capacity and the commitment to engage with its identified constituencies and communities.

WUT communicates regularly with faculty, staff, and students.

Faculty meetings are conducted every term.
Staff representatives meet with the Rector in a Staff Forum.
Student representatives from each program meet with the Rector in the Student Forum. Students run their independent office called the Student Council.
Students run their independent newspaper called CHAI.

WUT organizes Collage of Cultures (an event for students to share their cultures) and Alumni events annually.

WUT participates in events organized by our host city, Hua Hin, such as Beach Clean-up Day, the Annual Hua Hin Jazz Festival, and AIDS Awareness Day.

WUT provides English Placement Tests to local schools. WUT provides tailor-made Professional Development Programs to local and regional businesses.

5C) The organization demonstrates its responsiveness to those constituencies that depend on it for service.

WUT accepts credit transferred from any other accredited programs, however, students who wish to graduate with WUT degrees must earn at least 36 credit hours at WUT.

WUT offers a Buddhist Studies certificate, which is recognized by Webster University Worldwide.
