Student Leadership Awards Criteria

Individual Awards:

Students must have been enrolled during the current academic year.

Mark Govoni Emerging Leader Award

A first-year student with full-time status who must plan to return in the fall. Minimum GPA - 3.0. Contributions to extracurricular life, extracurricular involvement, and display emerging leadership skills. This award includes a \$150 prize from the Student Government Association.

Outstanding Contributions to Student Government Association

Minimum GPA - 2.5. Member of SGA. Contribution to student life through SGA and student organizations.

Outstanding Leadership of a Student Organization

Minimum GPA - 2.5, A student organization member or officer of a well-organized club, which has improved over previous year under their leadership and/or fiscal management.

Campus Voice Award

Minimum GPA - 2.5, Displays creativity and innovation in bringing issues to attention of the Dean of Student Affairs by shedding light on issues needing to be addressed in an assertive and articulate manner.

Campus Life Award

Minimum GPA - 2.5, Major contribution to campus social life and extracurricular activities through significant involvement in the programming efforts of campus clubs and/or departments. Awarded also for serving as a role model for students.

Global Citizen Award

Minimum GPA – 2.5. Recognizes demonstrated leadership in achieving the international mission of Webster University through promotion of international involvement and understanding. Such leadership is demonstrated by advancing institutional goals abroad or by highlighting advanced international perspectives at the Webster Groves campus.

Capstone Award for Leadership

This five-pronged Student Leadership Award indicates high achievements in the following components: a) GPA - 3.5 or greater b) significant extracurricular involvement c) multi-departmental/organizational involvement d) community service, and e) positive role model.

Organization Awards:

Most Improved Student Organization

Improvement in the organization and contribution to campus life over the past year

Outstanding Contributions to Campus Social Life

Club that has sponsored or co-sponsored activities throughout the year that have made a significant impact on the campus social life.

Outstanding Community Service

Club that has held successful event(s) on- or off-campus, contributing volunteer time to local agencies or individuals. Awarded for number of participants, number of events, and/or lasting impact of the service.

Outstanding Contributions to Cultural Awareness

Contributing to the increased awareness of cultural and/or social issues on a campus-wide scale, through a single event or a series of events throughout the year.

Mission-Critical Award

Student organization or employment group that fosters learning outside the classroom through its activities and events, benefiting Webster University by furthering its educational mission.

Outstanding Collaborative Effort by an Employment Group

A group of student employees that have cohesively accomplished teamwork among the organization, and/or the successful achievement of a single program, series of programs, or departmental goal. Members of this group serve as role models for the rest of the campus.

Group/Individual Award

Marketing Campaign Award

The individual or group that has created exceptional promotional material for an event (or series of events), displaying creativity, innovation, thoroughness, and ability to inform.
