#### Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

While students should meet the minimum eligibility requirements, this does not guarantee the award.

- Be a degree-seeking student of a member of the Webster International Network of Schools (WINS).
- Acceptance into a Webster University program at an international location.
- Good academic, social, and financial standing.
- Student must not currently receive tuition remission or tuition exchange benefits from Webster University.

#### Conditions of the Award:

- The WINS Travel Award must be coordinated through the Office of Study Abroad of Webster University.
- Travel arrangements must be made through TravelPlex, Webster University's travel agency in St. Louis, Missouri.
- Successfully complete a minimum of one eight-week term (at least six credit hours) abroad as a full-time equivalent student.
- If a student withdraws after the ticket has been purchased or does not successfully complete the term abroad with Webster University the amount of the award will be charged to the student.
- If the student decides to change the ticket once it has been booked, the student is financially responsible for any change fee and re-booking.
- Students are normally booked on flights with other study abroad students to ensure timely arrival and travel support from the local campus. Special travel requests may be considered, but are not guaranteed.
- Student must have the International Student Identification Card (ISIC) prior to the ticket being released to the student; such card to be provided by Webster's Office of Study Abroad.
- The award could be considered taxable.
- Students who receive the award must complete the Study Abroad student evaluation upon their return to the U.S.
- Noncompliance with the conditions of the award may result in revocation of the award.
