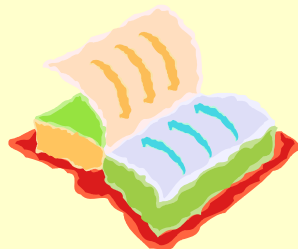

There are several important resources on the Website at [www.webster.edu](http://www.webster.edu), under **Current Students**: Please check it out!

- Click on Academic Advising to find important advising resources for the graduate and undergraduate classroom students.
- View Course Schedules and use "Power Search" to look for a particular class, instructor, time or day.
- Visit the Academic Resource Center for study tips or submit a paper to the Online Writing Center.
- Under Bookstore, look up the book for your class and order your book online.
- Under Technology Resources, learn more about Connections, your Webster E-mail Account and how to contact the HELP DESK or sign up for Text Alerts.
- View your Student Account Information and pay your bill. You will be notified by Webster E-mail when your bill is ready to view.
- Find your instructor's E-mail under Search Webster.

Are you looking for a syllabus for you class? There are a few places you may find it. The instructor may send it to your Webster E-mail or post it in your course (which is loaded into the system the Friday before the class begins); or you may check the syllabus cart next to the Westport front desk. If you need to reach your instructor via E-mail, go to the Search Webster function under "Current Student."

If you are going to miss a class, be sure to contact your instructor. Please note the drop and withdrawal dates listed in this newsletter.

Are you having trouble registering for your capstone class? If you are in progress with a required core class, the system will not allow you to register for your capstone class. We will be happy to assist you in registering. This is also a good time to visit with your advisor to ensure all requirements have been met for graduation. All students must fill out a "petition to graduate."

**Register early for Spring 1 & 2, 2010.** Campus will be closed from December 24-January 3. You may want to order your books early or pick it up on Thursday, Dec. 17 at our campus because after that date, the bookstore will not be at Westport until January 4, the first day graduate classes begin. If you would like to purchase your book before class begins, you may order online (Current Student, bookstore) or go to the main campus bookstore at 554 Garden, St. Louis, MO 63119.
