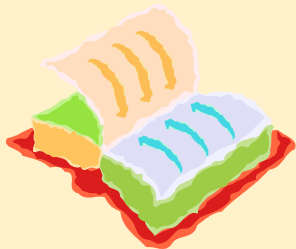

Tools for Building your Educational Future in 2012

Welcome to the New Year 2012 and time for making (and breaking) those New Year's Resolutions! What is on your list of resolutions for this year? Renew that fitness club membership, vow to walk those 10,000 steps a day for better health, swear off all desserts and fried foods, be more patient with your loved ones (especially going through the terrible twos and teenagers), volunteer in your local community, give more in time and money to your place of worship, and spend less and save more for retirement. These are all great resolutions, but you forgot one important item. Investing in your own educational future!

With this in mind, here are some tools that will help you mold the building blocks for starting and completing your Undergraduate or Graduate degree programs at Webster University at our WingHaven Campus. Getting started is easy. Make an appointment with me, so we can discuss your options and what is best for you as an individual. The application process is simple: submit your application, request official transcripts, and send us your resume. With these items in hand, we can start you on your path to the future and enroll you in the next term of classes. As a student at Webster University, you have many academic resources readily available and easily accessible.

Academic Resource Center – The ARC offers our students services such as The Writing Center and The Testing Center. These can be useful if you need additional support or are doing undergrad test-outs.

Career Services – Students may wish to utilize valuable career and job information.

Connections – Memorize your student ID number, User ID and Password, since you will use them throughout your degree program. You may view your student academic record, degree audit, invoices, payments, grades, and even register for graduate classes. Undergrads will contact me first.

Financial Aid – This is always a good starting point, whether using student loans, tuition assistance, scholarships, grants, or veterans administration benefits.

Graduate Students – If you already have a graduate degree, consider coming back for your Sequential (or 2nd grad degree) by taking the required core courses with no electives.

Library Resources – Our Library system is exceptional and offers everything online that a student could possibly need to research any topic for class papers and presentations.

Online Learning Center – The OLC offers graduate students several course choices each term for most of our graduate degree programs. Some undergraduate courses are also offered online.

Petition to Graduate – This is the final and most important aspect of your studies. All students must submit a Petition to Graduate prior to their last term of classes.

Undergraduate Students – There are a variety of ways to earn college credit for what you already know, i.e. testing out of CLEP/DANTES, completing a portfolio, and other prior learning assessment programs.
