* Minimum residency requirement: 30 of the last 36 credits required for the degree must be completed at Webster University.

[^] Minimum of 24 of the 36 required credits must be at the 3000-level or higher. Students must have a cumulative 3.0 GPA on the language courses at the 3000-level and higher. Nine (9) hours must be successfully completed at Webster University at the 3000-level or higher including an advanced language course, a literature course and a culture course. Also, a study abroad experience in a country where the target language is spoken is required. A portfolio review and demonstration of oral proficiency must be passed in a departmental overview.

[#] Courses completed with a grade lower than C- do not count toward fulfilling specific core requirements.

[<] Language courses taken at the community college not listed with equivalencies at Webster University may still be counted toward the appropriate major as part of the 12 credits acceptable at the 1000 and 2000 level.

⁺ Students who complete an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree before transferring to Webster University will have completed all of their general education requirements. Please refer to the Webster University Transfer Guide on General Education for more information.
